Will provide the leadership techniques and administrative tools to help individuals and local associations fulfill the mission of the UAI.



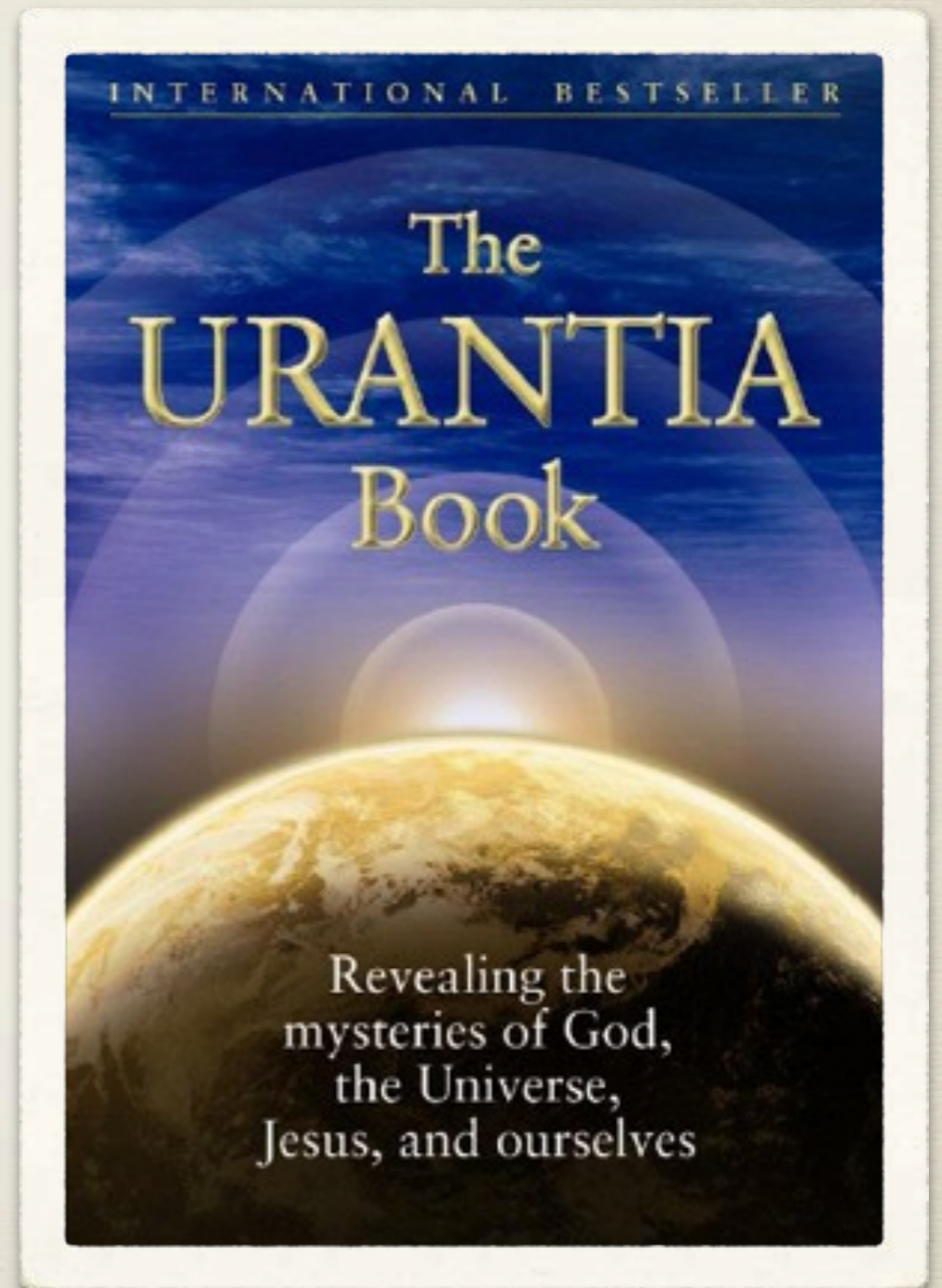
The Vision

- * Any readers and members with basic leadership skills and a desire to serve.



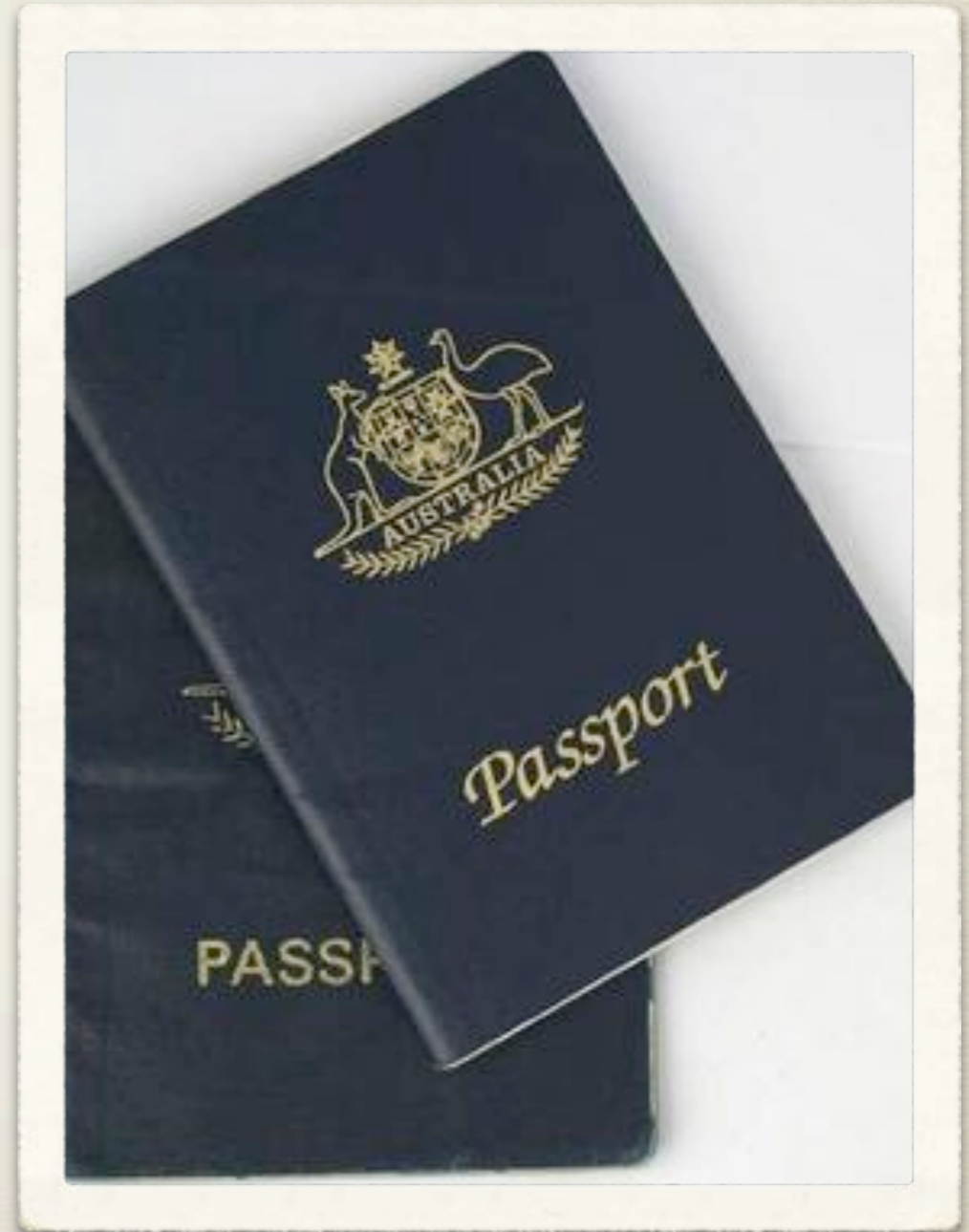
Probable cost per participant
